

Six-Pack Air Cleaner FAQ

What are the air cleaners made from?

6061T6 solid aluminum CNC milled to size

What carbs do they fit?

Any Holley 2300 with the half moon top or throat

Will these fit any Mopar?

They fit Mopar A bodies (Dart, Duster, Demon) that are running a small block using the factory (3) three two-barrel carb setup. They will fit any application with 2 1/4" from where the cleaner rests between the carb to the hood.

Are these for the 340 small block only?

No, they fit Holley 2300 two barrel carbs with the half moon top or throat. These are used on Mopar six-pack 440 big blocks, 340 small blocks, Chevy 427 tri-power and Ford tri-power engines. Hood clearance needs to be checked on any application.

Are they polished or coated?

No, they are fine mill finished so you can finish as you like. Some people want to paint them, etc. They can be polished, too.

Are any mods needed to the carbs?

Depends if your center carb is threaded for the hold down stud. Otherwise, no mods needed; they fit and clear all the external rods, choke, etc. The instruction manual covers how to tap the center carb stud mount if yours is not threaded.

What type of filter element is used?

The kits arrive with the typical reusable gauze and screen elements. These can be washed and re-oiled instead of replaced.

Is there a connection for the PCV tube from the valve cover breather?

No, for these cleaners the valve cover breather is not connected to the air cleaner.
